Green Belt Training

The Six Sigma Green Belt serves as a specially trained team member within his or her function-specific area of the organization. This focus allows the Green Belt to work on small, carefully defined Six Sigma projects, requiring less than a Black Belt's full-time commitment to Six Sigma throughout the business. Six Sigma Qualtec's Green Belt Training provides participants with enhanced problem-solving skills, with an emphasis on the MAIC (Measure-Analyze-Improve-Control) model.

The Green Belt has two primary tasks: first, to help successfully deploy Six Sigma techniques, and second, to lead small-scale improvement projects within their respective areas. As a support population, Green Belts can do much of the legwork in gathering data and executing experiments in support of a Black Belt project. As managers, they can significantly increase the Black Belt's effectiveness. The class of Green Belts going through training is called a "wave" in Six Sigma vernacular. Class size is typically 10 to 20 people.

The Program

Six Sigma Qualtec's Services Green Belt Training is a 3-month course involving 11 days of classroom training. Designed to enhance technical problem solving skills in line managers, instruction is application-focused and requires each participant to successfully complete a project during the classroom portion of the training.

Six Sigma Green Belt Training consists of three modules of classroom training, each followed by two-to three-week periods of "real world" application of newly acquired skills and knowledge. Green Belt students typically receive support in their work-related projects from their organization's certified Black Belts. Upon completion of training, the Green Belt not only has developed superior problem-solving skills that can be immediately applied, but has also completed a real-world project. Typically, the entire Green Belt training investment can be justified by results from the first project. **The median return on each SSQ-trained Green Belt is \$60,000 per project**
